I would also like this information for the same request and timeframe for 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018.

I would also like this data in a spreadsheet with cases broken down by date, location, age and gender, if possible. Also, if possible, what the object was that had been swallowed in each case.

We do not record data pertaining to a foreign object being swallowed.
