- 3. Please supply your total number (whole time equivalent and headcount) consultants and doctor in training staff in post by speciality and grade (for doctors in training) across your Trust.
- 4. Please supply your total number (WTE and headcount) consultants by sex, whether trained in the UK, EEA or other non-UK and the share who are from a BME group.
- 5. Please supply your total number of doctors in training by sex, and the share who are from a BME group.

In response to questions 3, 4 and 5, please see the attached information.

We are unable to identify where consultants have been trained from the records we hold in our systems.

Please also note that our Doctors in Training (apart from Foundation Doctors) are employed by Pennine, through a lead employer arrangement.
