- 3. The number of males receiving treatment for joint hypermobility at ages: 8, 9, 10, 11-12, 12-13, 13-14, 15-16, 16-17, and 17-18.

Diagnostic coding is currently only recorded sporadically against Outpatient attendances, therefore we are unable to provide details of any patients treated for Joint Hypermobility Syndrome in an Outpatient setting.
