Registered Nursing and Midwifery headcount – 1318

Medical and Dental headcount - 408

2. *How many (headcount) nurses took (any number of) sick days between: April 2016 to April 2017? Eg: 550 nurses*

Registered Nursing and Midwifery staff - 858

3. *How many (headcount) doctors took (any number of) sick days between: April 2016 to April 2017? Eg: 550 doctors*

Medical and Dental staff - 132

4. *How many (headcount) nurses who took sick leave during these time periods identified 'anxiety, stress, depression' (ASD) or other psychological condition? Eg: 329 nurses.*

Registered Nursing and Midwifery Staff – 115

5. *How many (headcount) doctors who took sick leave during these time periods*

*Identified 'anxiety, stress, depression' (ASD) or other psychological condition? **Eg: 34 doctors.***

Medical and Dental staff – 3
