We are now pleased to respond to your request for information under the FOI Act.

You asked:

I would be grateful if you could provide me with the following information:-

- 1. What was your total annual spend on cyber security in tax years?
 - a) $2014-2015 = \pounds 21,000$
 - b) 22015-2016 = £81,000
 - c) 2016-2017 = £85,000
 - d) 2017-2018 = £290,000
- 2. If any, how many successful and unsuccessful cyber-attacks did you have during the above years?
 - a) 2014 N/A
 - b) 2015 25160 attacks
 - c) 2016 60570 attacks
 - d) 2017 yearly figures not collated yet.
- 3. For the above years, what types of attacks or attempted attacks happened?

As above, attacks were predominately of UK/Global email malspam variety.

4. If any attacks were successful how did this happen and how was this dealt with?

Wannacry Ransomware attack as part of UK wide affected attack and was handled via IT Incident response team.

5. What is your current cyber security strategy?

The Trust currently employs and reviews security strategy from NHS Digital/IG Toolkit guidelines.
