Could you please give me figures for inpatient suicide – ie people who have killed themselves while being treated in hospital either on a ward as an inpatient or in an A and E department. Could I have figures for 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 please?


Refusal Notice; Having considered the Public Interest Test, due to the low numbers involved the Trust is applying Section 40 personal data and therefore we are unable to provide any further details.

Due to the low numbers involved there is a high risk that the family of an individual could be identified from the information that has been requested or from that information and other information that may be available. To disclose this information would:

- a) contravene the Data Protection Act principles in that it would amount to unfair and possibly unlawful processing, as there was a legitimate expectation by the third parties that this information would remain confidential, and
- b) disclosure may cause damage or distress to the individual(s) involved, and that damage or distress would be unwarranted (section 10 of the DPA).
