If none of the above and known please state where else.

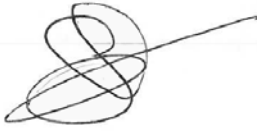
Also were each vacancy advertised also advertised within the UK

1. The Trust has not advertised for a specific number of vacancies. Our recruitment campaign is ongoing. There are, however approximately 80 vacancies a year.
2. We have advertised on the Trust Website, as well as the NHS Jobs website, and other UK advertising media. The advertisements were also run in the Scottish Herald newspaper and we have also engaged the services of a UK based agency to source applicants from the EU Market for our Staff Nurse Positions
