We are now pleased to respond to your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act.

You asked:

For the two groups, Medical/Dental Consultants and SAS doctors (Specialty and Associate Specialist doctors) please state separately for each group if you employed any that would have been eligible to apply at the time for a local Clinical Excellence Award/Employer Based Award for each of the financial years 2010-11, 2011-12, 2012-13, 2013-14 and 2014-15. Also for each group and year state if the Clinical Excellence Awards Scheme was run or not and if it was run when it was run. Also if you currently employ staff in these groups that would be eligible please state if you have or are to run the Scheme for 2015-16.

The Trust runs Local Clinical Excellence Awards each year (including this year) for all eligible Consultants, who must be substantive and have 1 years' service by 1 April each year.


The Panel meets during the autumn.
