The consultant shifts are 0800 - 1600, 1200 to 2000 and 1500 to 2300.

We do not hold this information for 2011

3 - The number of beds split by:

- Minors area 10 cubicles
- Majors area 16 cubicles
- Resuscitation area 5 bays
- Observation area (CDU) 10 beds + 1 sideward (in 2011 there were 9 +1)
