Listening to Hospital Radio at Wrightington Hospital

Things have changed at Wrightington. The new wards do not have points behind the beds to connect to hospital radio. You can pick up WWL Radio via our website by clicking on the Listen Live button or by downloading our App to your smart phone or tablet. Just look for Wrightington Hospital Radio.

However, there are some wards with standard 3.5mm stereo jack plug headsets. You can also use your own headset into this socket.

If you cannot get reception or if the headset is damaged then inform a member of the ward staff or a radio volunteer.

Listening to Hospital Radio at Royal Albert Edward Infirmary, Wigan

Beds on the wards in The Royal Albert Edward Infirmary are provided with a radio,TV, telephone system provided by Hospedia. It is free to listen to radio and Hospital Radio is available on channel 1.

There is a charge for access to television but NOT for radio.
