You asked:

1. For the 4 months from September to December 2022, how many patients received the following anti-VEGF treatments for any eye condition:

Aflibercept - 1275

Bevacizumab - 22

Brolucizumab - 25

Dexamethasone – 27 (intravitreal implants)

Faricimab - 13

Ranibizumab - Lucentis - 461

Ranibizumab - Ongavia - 0

Answers are the total number of packs issued – if patients revisit within the period, then this figure would count them multiple times

2. For the patients above, how many were new to anti-VEGF therapy? Please provide the patient numbers by the treatments listed below, excluding patients who previously had any anti-VEGF therapy

| Treatment | Total Patient | New Patient |

| Aflibercept (Eylea) | 720 | 63 |
| Bevacizumab (Avastin) | 36 | <5 |
| Brolucizumab (Beovu) | 12 | 0 |
| Dexamethasone | <5 | 0 |
| Dexamethasone (Ozurdex) | 46 | <5 |
| Ranibizumab (Lucentis) | 319 | 13 |
