With reference to your request for information received on 13<sup>th</sup> January 2025, I can confirm in accordance with Section 1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 that we do hold the information you have requested. A response to each part of your request is provided below.

In your request you asked:

## Please may I request the following information:

- **1.** Do you have a Virtual Ward or Hospital at Home Service? Yes, the Trust has a Virtual Ward service.
- 2. Please could I have a copy of your staffing structure for the Virtual Ward or Hospital at Home model you have?

- 3. Please could I have a copy of any Standard Operating Policies that you have as part of your Virtual Ward or Hospital at Home Service? Please see attached.
- 4. Do you have any process maps that detail the clinical and/or operational pathways that form your Virtual Ward or Hospital at Home Service? Please see attached.

5. Are your Acute Medical, General Medical, or Emergency Department Consultant workforce directly engaged in Virtual Ward or Hospital at Home service supervision? If so, is it a duty that is delivered during independent VW/HAH sessions or alongside their Acute Trust commitments?

No, they are not directly engaged in the Virtual Ward supervision.

6. Do Primary Care clinicians retain any responsibility for patients cared for by VW/HAH patients? Perhaps shared care of some patients with Acute Trust or dedicated VW/HAH clinicians is achieved?

The patient remains under the care of WWL until discharged from the Virtual Ward service. However, the responsibility of providing repeat medications and management of long-term conditions remains with Primary Care.
