With reference to your request for information received on 15th January 2025, I can confirm in accordance with Section 1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 that we do hold the information you have requested. A response to each part of your request is provided below.

In your request you asked:

I'd like to request the following records under the FOI act.

1. Virtual wards

- a. The total number of virtual ward beds you had open as of 15 January 2025 150.
- b. The total number of VW beds, broken down by the different specialties served by those virtual wards

Virtual Ward beds are not designated to specialities, patients will be admitted to the ward across several pathways following clinical triage.

c. The beds occupancy rate as of 15 January 2025, broken down by specialty The total Virtual Ward occupancy is 82%.

2. Patient initiated follow-up

a. A list of the specialities for which you offer patient initiated follow-up Breast Surgery, Cardiology, Colorectal Surgery, Community Paediatrics, Dermatology, Diabetic Medicine, ENT, Gastroenterology, General Surgery, Gynaecology, Hepatology, Ophthalmology, Oral Surgery, Orthodontics, Orthoptics, Paediatrics, Paediatric Cardiology, Paediatric, Endocrinology, Pain Management, Physiotherapy, Plastic Surgery, Rheumatology, Thoracic Medicine, Trauma & Orthopaedics, Urology and Vascular Surgery

- b. The proportion of outpatient attendances discharged to PIFU pathways, as of 15 January 2025 (or the most recent data point please specify the date if different from 15/1/25)

 None. Patients are discharged at the same time as putting them on the PIFU waiting list.
