## Dear Sir/Madam

With reference to your request for information received on 18th February 2025, I can confirm in accordance with Section 1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 that we do not hold the information you have requested. A response to each part of your request is provided below.

In your request you asked:

1. Any data on hospital admissions, A&E visits, or GP consultations where nicotine pouches were recorded as a contributing factor, for 2023, 2024, and 2025. Please disaggregate this data by:

- Type of admission (eg A&E visit, hospital admission or GP consultation)
- Year
- Age of patient (either under 18 or over 18)
- Health condition related to nicotine pouch use

2. Any data on patients with recorded dental or oral health conditions linked to nicotine pouch use within your Trust's dental services, for 2023, 2024 and 2025. Please disaggregate this data by:

- Year
- Age of patient (either under 18 or over 18)
- Type of oral health condition

The Trust does not have a specific code for Nicotine pouches. Therefore, we are unable to provide this data as it is not recorded centrally, if recorded it would be held within individual case notes. As case notes are for the care and treatment of patients, we do not request staff to interrogate them to collate the information required to respond to Freedom of Information requests.
