## Dear Sir/Madam

With reference to your request for information received on 8<sup>th</sup> August 2024, I can confirm in accordance with Section 1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 that we do hold the information you have requested. A response to each part of your request is provided below.

In your request you asked:

- 1. Can you advise how many CPAP machines are in use in the community provided by WWL? There are 4,486 active devices.
- 2. Can you advise how many CPAP machines are in use in the community that are outside of their expected service date?

- 3. Has a risk assessment been completed in relation to use of CPAP equipment being used outside of its service date in the community?

  Yes.
- 4. If a risk assessment has been completed, please can you provide a copy of this?

  The risk is a small part of a larger risk. The Trust does not have a risk assessment specifically for the use of CPAP equipment being used outside of its service date in the community.
- 5. Does the Trust allow out of service date equipment to be used on Trust premises?

  WWL is utilising a maintenance-free CPAP machine that does not require any servicing. The manufacturer suggests a useable blower hour, which needs be replaced with a new machine after it has reached its run time.
- 6. If you do, how many are in use on Trust Premises that are beyond their service date?
