With reference to your request for information received on 23rd August 2024, I can confirm in accordance with Section 1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 that we do hold the information you have requested. A response to each part of your request is provided below.

In your request you asked:

I am writing to formally request information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 from the Temporary Staffing Procurement Department. Specifically, I would like to request the following details:

1. The total Trust expenditure on framework agencies for the provision of Registered General Nurses, Registered Mental Health Nurses, and Health Care Assistants from 1st January 2024 to 30th June 2024.

Registered General Nurses = \pounds 11,859. Registered Mental Health Nurses = \pounds 0. Health Care Assistants = \pounds 0.

- 2. The total Trust expenditure on off-framework agencies for the provision of Registered General Nurses, Registered Mental Health Nurses, and Health Care Assistants for the same period. No off-framework agency usage.
- The total Trust expenditure through the internal Trust bank from 1st January 2024 to 30th June 2024. £9,925,487.
- 4. The total number of Nursing and Health Care Assistant shifts booked during this period. 36,987.

5. The total number of Nursing and Health Care Assistant shifts booked above NHSE capped rates during this period.
