You recently had the 'combined test' to screen for Down's syndrome, Edwards' syndrome and Patau's syndrome. We have used the following information about you along with information from your dating scan to perform this screening test

This has shown that your baby has a lower chance of having these conditions. Your individual chances for this pregnancy are as follows:

Chance of Down's Syndrome - 1 in 5000

Chance of Edwards' or Patau's Syndromes - 1 in 5000

We do not offer further testing at this level of chance. A lower chance result does not mean that there is no chance at all that the baby has Down's syndrome, Edwards' syndrome or Patau's syndrome, just that it is unlikely.
