## Dear Sir/Madam

With reference to your request for information received on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2025, I can confirm in accordance with Section 1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 that we do hold the information you have requested. A response to each part of your request is provided below.

In your request you asked:

- 1. How many amputation surgeries have been performed at your NHS trust since 2017? 459.
- How many upper limb amputation surgeries have been performed at your NHS trust since 2017?
   111.
- 3. How many lower limb amputation surgeries have been performed at your NHS trust since 2017? 332.
- 4. Please provide a breakdown of the primary causes for amputation surgeries at your NHS trust since 2017.

The Trust is unable to provide this data as it is not recorded centrally, if recorded it would be held within individual case notes. As case notes are for the care and treatment of patients, we do not request staff to interrogate them in order to collate the information required to respond to Freedom of Information requests.

- 5. How many active amputation cases were managed by your NHS trust between 1 January 2024 and 31 December 2024? Please provide the figure broken down by gender and the following age groups:
  - Baby (up to 1 year) = 0.
  - Toddler (1 to 3 years) = 0.
  - Child (4 to 12 years) = 0.

- Teenager (13 to 19 years) = 0.
- Young people (20 to 24 years) = 0.
- Adult (25 to 64 years) = 31. 25 male and 6 female.
- Older people (65 and over) = 36. 24 male and 12 female.
