## Dear Sir/Madam

With reference to your request for information received on 10<sup>th</sup> April 2025, I can confirm in accordance with Section 1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 that we do not hold the information you have requested. A response to each part of your request is provided below.

In your request you asked:

- 1. I would like the below information for each of the past five compete years (2020-2024).
  - Waiting times for further investigation referrals from GPs for prostate cancer patients.
  - Waiting times for treatment (surgery, radiotherapy, hormone therapy, chemotherapy) for prostate cancer patients.
  - Waiting times for further investigation referrals from GPs for head and neck cancer patients.
  - Waiting times for treatment (surgery, radiotherapy, immunotherapy, chemotherapy) for head and neck cancer patients.

**Clarification requested:** Please can you clarify whether "waiting times" means the overall average waiting time?

Response: Yes, "waiting times" means the overall average (mean) waiting time per year.

**Clarification requested:** Can you also clarify which investigations you are referring to in "further investigations"?

Response: I mean the waiting time between a referral from a GP to seeing a specialist in hospital.

The Trust reports cancer waiting times by 28 days, 31 days and 62 days meaning we are unable to obtain the mean waiting time. We would only be able to establish that patients are on the cancer waiting list and would not be able to identify the type of cancer the patient has as this is not centrally recorded, if recorded it would be held within individual case notes. As case notes are for the care and treatment of patients, we do not request staff to interrogate them in order to collate the information required to respond to Freedom of Information requests.
