Q2. How many patients were treated in the last 3 months by the Dermatology department for HS (Hidradenitis Suppurativa) ONLY with the following:

- Adalimumab Humira
- Adalimumab Biosimilar
- Bimekizumab
- Certolizumab
- Infliximab Remicade
- Infliximab Biosimilar
- Secukinumab
- Ustekinumab Stelara
- Ustekinumab Biosimilar

The were no patients receiving medications from Dermatology where the diagnosis was listed as Hidradenitis Suppurativa.
