With reference to your request for information received on 3rd July 2025, I can confirm in accordance with Section 1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 that we do hold the information you have requested. A response to each part of your request is provided below.

In your request you asked:

1. I would like to know the number of instances at this NHS Trust between May 2020 and May 2025, where treating a patient who has overdosed on a potent synthetic opioid has involved the hospital having to use its entire supply of naloxone.

The Trust has no record of using its entire supply of naloxone during this time period.

Please provide me with the following information if possible:

- Date of the incident
- Age and gender of the patient
- Type of synthetic opioid which led to the overdose (if known)
- Volume of naloxone required to treat the patient
- Impact on the hospital's stock of naloxone (e.g how much was used)
- Action taken by the hospital as a result (e.g was a shortage officially declared?)
