With reference to your request for information received on 17th October 2025, I can confirm in accordance with Section 1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 that we do hold the information you have requested. A response to each part of your request is provided below.

In your request you asked:

1. Month-on-month the number of people prescribed by your NHS trust weight loss jabs

E.g.

January: 1,200

February 1,000

0. As per current NHSE and GMMMG commissioning position we do not provide “weight loss jabs” as they are only permitted to be provided by specialist weight management centres of which there aren’t any in Greater Manchester currently. Any supply of the agents would be for their alternative licensed uses.

2. What types of jabs they were - broken down by figures

E.g.

January: 600 Ozempic, 600 Mounjaro

3. The ages of the people prescribed - and, if available, the jabs. Please include anyone under 10 - and ideally the youngest

E.g.

0-10: nine people (youngest four)

10-20: 30 people

N/A. Please see the response to question 1.

4. Any admissions to hospital you've had where the primary reason for being there was an adverse reaction to a jab

The Trust is unable to provide a response to this question as we do not have specific codes for Semaglutide, Ozempic or Mounjaro. The Trust would use Y42.3 Insulin and Oral Hypoglycaemic (antidiabetic) drugs in secondary position to the side effect caused as they are antidiabetic drugs used for weight loss. However, this code covers all anti-diabetic drugs in general therefore would not provide a response to your question.
