Please could we submit the following questions regarding lipoprotein(a) (Lp(a)) testing at your organisation.

Question 1: Does Wrightington, Wigan and Leigh NHS Foundation Trust test patients for raised levels of lipoprotein(a)?	Yes, on an ad-hoc basis.
Question 2: Does Wrightington, Wigan and Leigh NHS Foundation Trust have any guidelines or policies for the treatment of patients diagnosed with elevated* levels of lipoprotein(a)? *Elevated Lp(a) defined as >90 nmol/L.	No. Pathology at Wigan and Salford (PAWS) is based at Salford therefore WWL does not have a testing policy or any formal guidelines at present. If Yes, please provide a copy = N/A.
