With reference to your request for information received on 1<sup>st</sup> December 2025, I can confirm in accordance with Section 1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 that we do hold the information you have requested. A response to each part of your request is provided below.

In your request you asked:

**1. What is the required frequency for statutory BLS training?**

There is no statutory requirement in the UK to undertake any Resuscitation training. There is no legal statute.

**2. What incentives or measures has the trust adopted to encourage annual BLS training for medical professionals with patient facing duties ( no pay progression if mandatory training not completed, departmental sessions, ESR alerts, managerial supervision of mandatory training etc)?**

It is a contractual requirement to attend mandated annual Level 2 Resuscitation training. All of the above stated in brackets apply. Non-compliance should be discussed in appraisals and 1:1's. It is also a Governing Royal College recommendation to attend Level 2 Resuscitation.

**3. Does the organisation require resus teams to have Advanced Life Support training?**

Yes, and this is following RCUK G2025 recommendations.
