With reference to your request for information received on 1<sup>st</sup> December 2025, I can confirm in accordance with Section 1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 that we do hold the information you have requested. A response to each part of your request is provided below.

In your request you asked:

- 1. How many patients were treated in November 2025 (or latest available month) by the Dermatology department with the following drugs:**
  - **Abrocitinib (Cibinquo)** = 3.
  - **Baricitinib (Olumiant)** = 0.
  - **Dupilumab (Dupixent)** = 29.
  - **Lebrikizumab (Ebglyss)** = 1.
  - **Omalizumab (Xolair)** = 1.
  - **Tralokinumab (Adtralza)** = 2.
  - **Upadacitinib (Rinvoq)** = 6.
  - **Nemolizumab (Nemluvio)** = 0.
  
- 2. How many patients were treated in November 2025 (or latest available month) by the Respiratory Medicine departments with the following drugs:**
  - **Benralizumab (Fasenra)** = 32.
  - **Dupilumab (Dupixent)** = 1.
  - **Mepolizumab (Nucala)** = 3.
  - **Omalizumab (Xolair)** = 14.
  - **Reslizumab (Cinqaero)** = 0.
  - **Tezepelumab (Tezspire)** = 10.

The above information is based on October 2025. The Trust is unable to provide the information for November 2025 currently, due to waiting for the data from our Service Level Agreement provider.
