With reference to your request for information received on 8th December 2023, I can confirm in accordance with Section 1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 that we do hold the information you have requested. A response to each part of your request is provided below.

In your request you asked:

1. How many patients have been treated (for any condition) in the last 4 months with:

- **Benralizumab** = 17
- **Dupilumab** = 58
- **Omalizumab** = 33
- **Reslizumab** = 0
- **Mepolizumab** = 12
- **Tezepelumab** = 0

2. How many patients have been treated in the last 4 months by the Respiratory Medicines Department ONLY with:

- **Dupilumab** = 0
- **Omalizumab** = 30
