With reference to your request for information received on 4th December 2023, I can confirm in accordance with Section 1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 that we partially hold the information you have requested. A response to each part of your request is provided below.

In your request you asked:

The questions a cover the period of 1st September 2018 to 1st September 2023:

1) The total number of medical doctors employed at your institution, broken down by professional grade (e.g., FY1, FY2, CT1, CT2, SpR, Associate Specialist, Consultant). If you cannot provide this break down, please provide the total for doctors of all grades.

Please see the attached Spreadsheet.

2) The total number of clinical incidents reported where after investigation it was found that a medical doctor was responsible for the incident. If possible, please categorized by each professional grade. If you cannot provide this break down, please provide the total for doctors of all grades.

This information is not held on our system. The Trust would be unable to breakdown incidents reported by staff grade. Incidents are reported by category or subcategory. To determine who reported the incident the trust would need to review each incident and cross reference records held in HR to determine position at the trust. This would take over the legal time frame to do.
