With reference to your request for information received on 31st January 2024, I can confirm in accordance with Section 1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 that we do hold the information you have requested. A response to each part of your request is provided below.

In your request you asked:

1. Which wheelchair services do you oversee

Wrightington Wigan and Leigh, Community Division, Wheelchairs and Specialist Seating.

2. When providing a powered wheelchair do you have specific criteria regarding ramping and the width of internal doorframes. When considering a ramp into a home what are the lengths and angle requirements and what door measurements are acceptable

As part of the assessment process an "Environmental" assessment is carried out. If a ramp or internal doorways require widening the client is advised to contact Community OT to have advice regarding provision of these alterations and to get back in touch with the wheelchair service once these adaptations are done. In some cases, a driving assessment will also be completed. This depends on whether the wheelchair can get into the house. A portable ramp may be used to access the house.

3. Do you offer personal wheelchair budgets to your service users Yes

4. Are people living with Motor Neurone Diseased prioritised in your services and what is the normal waiting time for an initial assessment.

Prioritisation is completed on each referral at triaging based on individual needs. Currently initial assessment is approximately 6 weeks.
