With reference to your request for information received on 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2024, I can confirm in accordance with Section 1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 that we do hold the information you have requested. A response to each part of your request is provided below.

In your request you asked:

For the period 1 January 2024 to 31 June 2024, please provide:

- The number of women / birthing people diverted to other NHS trusts (please specify which) to give birth to their baby Less than 5.
- a) Please break down by reason for diversion, i.e. lack of staff Please see exemption below.
- 2. The number of women / birthing people diverted to other hospitals within your NHS trust (different to the one they planned to give birth in) to give birth to their baby N/A.
- a) Again, please break down by reason for diversion N/A.

The Trust is unable to breakdown the number of women / birthing people diverted to other NHS Trusts to give birth to their baby due to there being less than 5 patients. Disclosing the reasoning could make patients identifiable. Please see below.

The Trust has a policy of not releasing information when the data involved is less than 5. This is because we feel that such low numbers could make the individuals involved identifiable and therefore may cause undue harm and distress.

To disclose this information would:

- a) Contravene the Data Protection Act principles in that it would amount to unfair and possibly unlawful processing, as there was a legitimate expectation by the third parties that this information would remain confidential, and
- b) Disclosure may cause damage or distress to the individual(s) involved, and that damage or distress would be unwarranted (section 10 of the DPA).
