With reference to your request for information received on 17th June 2024, I can confirm in accordance with Section 1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 that we do hold the information you have requested. A response to each part of your request is provided below.

In your request you asked:

1. How many NHS staff are on leave for mental health issues and/or sickness between the 12/06/23 and 12/06/24

There were 5,579 staff who had a sickness episode recorded within the period 12/06/23 and 12/06/24. This is inclusive of all sickness absence reasons, including anxiety / stress / depression / other psychiatric illnesses.

a. Of those absentees, can you provide the 20 most prevalent reasons for sickness absences?

- Anxiety/stress/depression/other psychiatric illnesses
- Other known causes not elsewhere classified
- Cold, Cough, Flu Influenza
- Other musculoskeletal problems
- Gastrointestinal problems
- Injury, fracture
- Pregnancy related disorders
- Back Problems
- · Genitourinary & gynaecological disorders
- Chest & respiratory problems
- Infectious diseases
- Benign and malignant tumours, cancers
- Heart, cardiac & circulatory problems
- Ear, nose, throat (ENT)
- Headache / migraine

- Nervous system disorders
- Eye problems
- Unknown causes / Not specified
- Skin disorders
- Dental and oral problems
- b. On any given day, on average how many staff are absent from work for sickness absences? On average, there are 401 members of staff absent due to sickness per day.
- c. Can you provide a breakdown of what staff group had the most absences for sickness between 12/06/23 and 12/06/24

Nursing and Midwifery staff group had the most FTE days absent in respect of sickness during this period.
