Helping children's understanding





Using gestures, real objects, or pictures will help children to understand what you are talking about.
This helps to show them what you mean

You can make comments and describe what your child is doing instead of asking of questions. This will help children to learn new words

Saying your child's name before giving them an instruction will gain their attention and help them to focus on what you've said

Breaking down long instructions into chunks will help your child to understand

Children need thinking time. When you ask them a question, give "10 seconds thinking time" before repeating what you have said
