£244,802 PA at the point when the MES commences (which is anticipated to be approximately September 2020)

9. How long is the contract for the system, and when does it expire?

The MES was due to start in approximately June 2019 and run for 5 years (between 1-6-19 to 30-6-24) at the point when the new equipment went live (at which point the old GE PACS contract would be cancelled). The 'Go Live' date has not yet commenced (but anticipated to do so in approximately September 2020). This may result in the new MES running an additional year (between 1-9-20 to 31-8-25) in order to fulfil the 5 year time period.

10. What is the overall lifetime cost of the system?

The following is the cost of the GE PACS Service during 2013 -14 to 2024-25 (with this final year being as a result of commencing the 5 year MES late from approximately September 2020, which will then potentially need to run for the full 5 years):
